Worthy Stables Junior Volunteers Code of Conduct

*Please read over and discuss this code with your child before signing.

- 1. I will read attached barn rules and follow them.
- 2. I understand that working with horses comes with some amount of danger and will follow rules and instructions because they are in place for my safety.

- 3. I will treat other Stable Kids participants how I want to be treated. Bullying, cussing, hitting, pushing, or unkind treatment are never acceptable.
- 4. I will treat the animals at Worthy Stables respectfully. Harming or rough handling of an animal is a zero tolerance offense and will result in my removal from the program.
- 5. I understand working at a horse facility requires maturity and hard work. I will strive to be at my best.
- 6. I will speak up and ask questions so I can learn and grow as a person and member of this group.
- 7. I will let an adult know if I have needs during my time at Worthy Stables. I will speak up if I am hot,

tired, feeling unwell, frustrated, or otherwise uncomfortable. My safety and well-being are important.

Some additional policies:

Stable Kids must be picked up by 4:00. First late pick-up will result in a \$25 fee. Second late pick-up will result in removal from program.

Drop-off is at the specified time. Please don't drop your child off early.

Sign your child in and out by texting their name to 601-337-8414 as you arrive at and leave the stables.

If gate code changes, we will notify you by text.

We will provide bottled water and light snacks. Other drinks and snacks are available for purchase in the honor bar in the classroom for \$1.50 a piece.

Do not bring your child to the stables sick. If they have been sick or had a fever in the last 24 hours, please keep them at home. We serve a medically fragile population and have to be diligent with this precaution.
